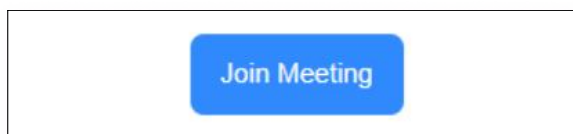
This email will include the Zoom meeting link and event details.

At the scheduled time, click the Join Meeting button in your email.



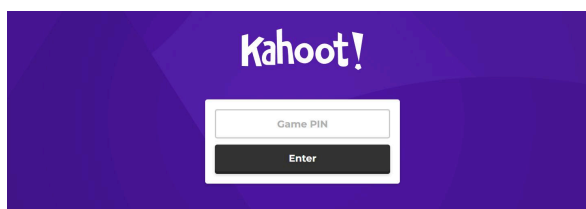

On a second device (such as a phone or tablet), open [Kahoot.it](https://kahoot.it) in a browser.

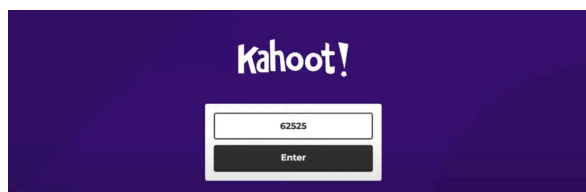

The GAME PIN will be displayed on the Zoom screen.



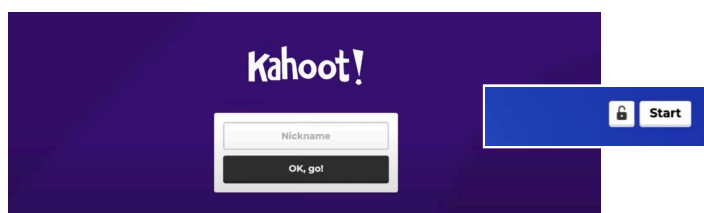
Enter the GAME PIN on your Kahoot device and press Enter.

Enter the KAHOOT UNIQUE ID as Nickname

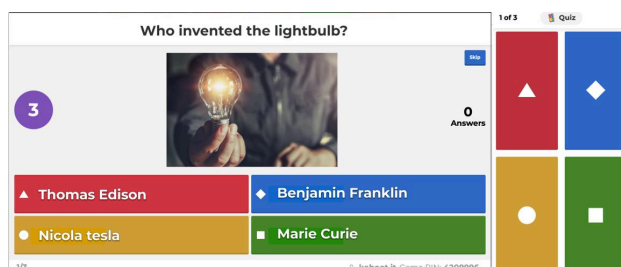

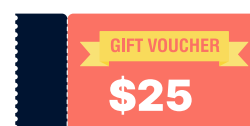

Let A Dictionary Be Your Go-to Source



Make a habit of learning new words by referring to a dictionary, whether a physical one or an online version.

Start with 15-20 words and gradually increase the number. Keep a list of difficult words and practice them until you master them. Online dictionaries can also provide pronunciation, usage examples, and synonyms to enhance your learning.

Create Flashcards of Newly Learned Words

- 1. Individual Registration:** Each student must register separately to participate in the event.

- 6. Unique Kahoot Participant IDs:** Each participant will receive a unique kahoot ID via email or SMS. Please keep it safe and check your spam/junk folder if you do not receive any communication.
