After registering, you will receive a confirmation email at your registered email ID.

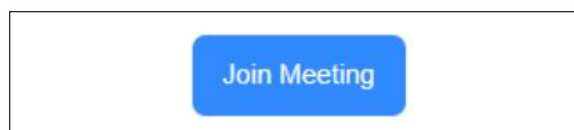
This email will include the Zoom meeting link and event details.

At the scheduled time, click the Join Meeting button in your email.



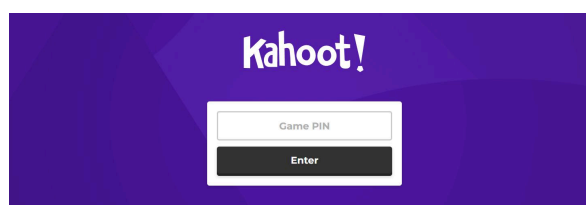
Recommended Device: Laptop/Desktop for the best experience.

On a second device (such as a phone or tablet), open [Kahoot.it](https://kahoot.it) in a browser.

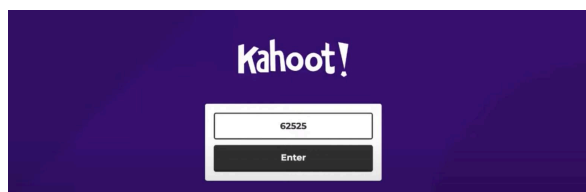

The GAME PIN will be displayed on the Zoom screen.



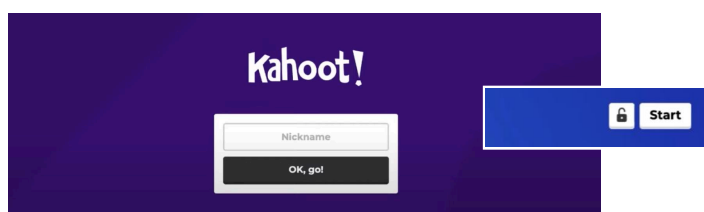
Enter the GAME PIN on your Kahoot device and press Enter.

Enter the KAHOOT UNIQUE ID as Nickname

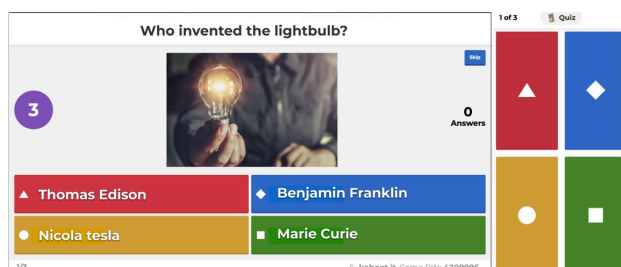


Click the **"Start"** button to begin!

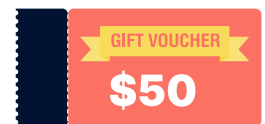

## GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW

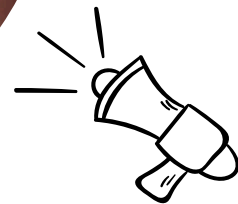
- 1. Individual Registration:** Each student must register separately to participate in the event.
- 2. Multiple Registrations:** If registering more than one child, a separate unique ID will be provided for each child in a common email.
- 3. Technical Readiness:** Participants must ensure a stable internet connection and a fully charged device before the event.
- 4. Identity Verification:** Winners must verify their identity to claim awards and scholarships. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 5. Winner Recognition:** Selected winners may be featured on our social media channels post-event.
- 6. Unique Kahoot Participant IDs:** It will be shared with you live during the event by the event host.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Entry Rights:** This is a 100% Free private event. The organizing team reserves the right to disqualify any participant found violating the rules or engaging in inappropriate behavior.
- 2. Event Format:** The event will be conducted via Kahoot, with points awarded based on speed and accuracy.
- 3. Winner Announcement:** Winners will be announced on the event day itself.
- 4. Scholarships and awards must be claimed within 15 days of the event; failure to do so will result in forfeiture.**
- 5. Scholarships are applicable only for new subscriptions and cannot be used for renewals.**
- 6. Students who have already won more than two awards or scholarships in the last two years are not eligible for a scholarship, even if they win the event.**
